We welcome to the pulpit today the Rev. Dr. Angela N. Parker, Assistant Professor of New Testament and Greek at the James and Carolyn McAfee School of Theology at Mercer University. Dr. Parker received her B.A. in Religion and Philosophy from Shaw University, her M.T.S from Duke Divinity School, and her Ph.D. in Bible, Culture, & Hermeneutics from Chicago Theological Seminary. She teaches courses in New Testament, Greek Exegesis, the Gospel of Mark, the Corinthian Correspondence and the Gospel of John. In her research she merges Womanist thought and postcolonial theory while reading biblical texts with real lived experiences of actual bodies. Her forthcoming book is entitled *Bodies, Violence, Motions: A Womanist Study of the Gospel of Mark*. Dr. Parker is also an ordained missionary Baptist clergyperson and connects her research to her clergy activities. In addition to her teaching and research, Dr. Parker serves as co-chair for the Paul & Politics Seminar of the Society of Biblical Literature and is a committee member of American Academy of Religion's Status of Racial and Ethnic Minorities Committee.
